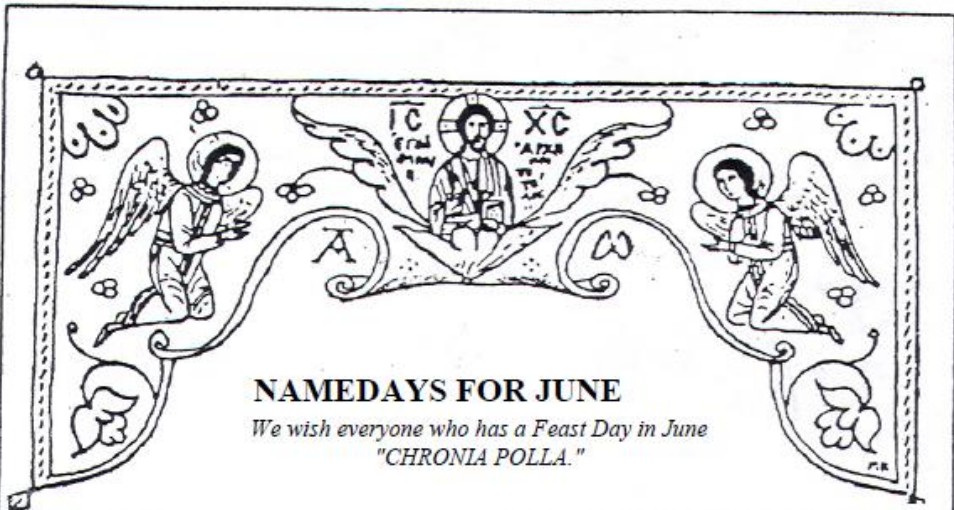

MESSAGE FROM FATHER JOHN HAYDEN HABY:

I have frequently written a warning about taking a summer vacation from church. Now is the season we enter into a “summer mind set” as we take a break in our catechism classes, as the academic school year comes to an end, as some graduate to go on to the next chapter in their lives, and as some go away for extended or short vacations. While the respite is refreshing, also we enter a “summer lull”. Unfortunately, some use this time period to take a vacation from church. While this might be understandable it has its downsides. Satan does not take a summer vacation. When we stay away from regular worship we make ourselves more vulnerable to Satan’s attacks. How would we feel if God took a summer vacation and we had an urgent need arise?

We face a dangerous and insidious trap of opening the door to Satan’s deception from taking this summer off. First, taking a summer break from church feels good. We can sleep in and have a lazy Sunday. Satan reminds us how nice it feels to miss church and even deceives us into thinking we can be just as spiritual by praying at home. Second, it opens the door to prioritizing our leisure over our spirituality and before we know it, our following Christ becomes much less important in our lives. God commands our spirituality to be a constant part of our lives. Unlike sports, no “off season” exists in our following Christ. Finally, we risk coming back spiritually weaker when the summer ends.

On a separate note, so far, our parish had been really blessed year. The parish’s hard work has been recognized by our parish receiving a Small Parish Grant.

Μετά τὴν Ανάληψη τοῦ Κυρίου στους οὐρανοὺς, οἱ Ἀπόστολοι καὶ οἱ ὑπόλοιποι μαθητὲς τοῦ, καθὼς καὶ οἱ γυναῖκες ποὺ ἀπὸ τὴν ἀρχὴ τὸν εἶχαν ἀκολουθήσει, ἡ Παναγία Παρθένος Μαρία ἡ Μητέρα τοῦ, περίπου 120 ἄτομα, γύρισαν στο ὄρος τῶν Ἐλαιῶν στὴν Ἱερουσαλὴμ καὶ, μπαίνοντας στο ὑπερῶο, δηλαδὴ στὸν πάνω ὄροφο τοῦ σπιτιοῦ ἐκεῖ, περίμεναν με προσευχὴ τὴν ἐπιφοίτηση τοῦ Ἁγίου Πνεύματος, σύμφωνα με τὴν υπόσχεση τοῦ Σωτήρα Χριστοῦ. Τώρα γνωρίζουν ποια εἶναι ἡ προοπτικὴ τῆς καινῆς ζωῆς καὶ ποὺ πρέπει νὰ οδηγήσουν τὸ λαό, γι' αὐτὸ καὶ τοὺς πρώτους τρεῖς χιλιάδες ποὺ βαπτίστηκαν, τοὺς οδηγοῦν στο Δεῖπνο τῆς Ζωῆς, τὴν Τράπεζα τῆς Θεῆς Ευχαριστίας, ὅπου στο ἐξῆς θὰ βρίσκεται συναγμένη ἡ Ἐκκλησία ὡς σῶμα Χριστοῦ, θὰ τρέφεται με τὸ Σῶμα καὶ τὸ Αἷμα τοῦ Κυρίου καὶ θὰ συμμετέχει ἔτσι στὴν αἰώνια ζωὴ τῆς Βασιλείας τοῦ Θεοῦ.

Με τὴν Πεντηκοστὴ δὲν γεννήθηκε ἡ Ἐκκλησία ὡς ἀπλὸς θεσμὸς, ἀλλὰ ὡς συνεχῆς παρουσία τῆς χάριτος τοῦ Ἁγίου Πνεύματος, καὶ γι' αὐτὸ ἡ Πεντηκοστὴ δὲν εἶναι ἓνα γεγονός ποὺ συνέβη μιὰ φορὰ κάποτε, ἀλλὰ εἶναι ἡ ζωὴ τῆς Ἐκκλησίας, ὡς ἀδιάκοπη κοινωνία τοῦ Ἁγίου Πνεύματος.

PENTECOST

The Feast commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles on the day of Pentecost, a feast of the Jewish tradition. It also celebrates the establishment of the Church through the preaching of the Apostles and the baptism of the thousands who on that day believed in the Gospel message of salvation through Jesus Christ. The Feast is also seen as the culmination of the revelation of the Holy Trinity.

The story of Pentecost is found in the book of The Acts of the Apostles. In Chapter two we are told that the Apostles of our Lord were gathered together in one place. Suddenly, a sound came from heaven like a rushing wind, filling the entire house where they were sitting. Then, tongues of fire appeared, and one sat upon each one of Apostles. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages as directed by the Spirit (Acts 2:1-4).

This miraculous event occurred on the Jewish Feast of Pentecost, celebrated by the Jews on the fiftieth day after the Passover as the culmination of the Feast of Weeks (Exodus 34:22; Deuteronomy 16:10). The Feast of Weeks began on the third day after the Passover with the presentation of the first harvest sheaves to God, and it concluded on Pentecost with the offering of two loaves of unleavened bread, representing the first products of the harvest (Leviticus 23:17-20; Deuteronomy 16:9-10).

Since the Jewish Feast of Pentecost was a great pilgrimage feast, many people from throughout the Roman Empire were gathered in Jerusalem on this day. When the people in Jerusalem heard the sound, they came together and heard their own languages being spoken by the Apostles (Acts 2:5-6). The people were amazed, knowing that some of those speaking were Galileans, and not men who would normally speak many different languages. They wondered what this meant, and some even thought the Apostles were drunk (Acts 2:7-13).

Peter, hearing these remarks, stood up and addressed the crowd. He preached to the people regarding the Old Testament prophecies about the coming of the Holy Spirit. He spoke about Jesus Christ and His death and glorious Resurrection. Great conviction fell upon the people, and they asked the Apostles, "What shall we do?" Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit" (Acts 2:38-39).

The Bible records that on that day about three thousand were baptized. Following, the book of Acts states that the newly baptized continued daily to hear the teaching of the Apostles, as the early Christians met together for fellowship, the breaking of bread, and for prayer. Many wonderful signs and miracles were done through the Apostles, and the Lord added to the Church daily those who were being saved (Acts 2:42-47).

Άγιοι Πέτρος και Παύλος Πρωτοκορυφαίοι Απόστολοι Ιουνίου 29

Ο Πέτρος καταγόταν από τη Βηθσαϊδά της Γαλιλαίας και ήταν γιος του Ιωνά, αδελφός του Αποστόλου Ανδρέα του Πρωτόκλητου. Ο Πέτρος και ο Ανδρέας ήταν ψαράδες στη λίμνη Γεννησαρέτ. Είχε νυμφευθεί στην Καπερναούμ, όπου έμενε οικογενειακά μαζί με την πεθερά του. Όπως μας πληροφορεί το Ευαγγέλιο, όταν ο Ιησούς έφθασε στη λίμνη της Γεννησαρέτ συνάντησε τους δυο αδελφούς Πέτρο και Ανδρέα οι οποίοι έριχναν τα δίχτυα τους. Αμέσως μετά την κλήση τους, άφησαν τα δίχτυα και τις οικογένειές τους και τον ακολούθησαν. Ψαράς στο επάγγελμα, ήταν τύπος αυθόρμητος, ορμητικός, και τη ζωή του κοντά στο Χριστό τη μαθαίνουμε από τα τέσσερα Ευαγγέλια, ενώ την αποστολική του δράση, από τις πράξεις των Αποστόλων. Έγραψε και δύο Καθολικές Επιστολές, μέσα στις οποίες να τι προτρέπει τους χριστιανούς: «Νήψατε, γρηγορήσατε, ο αντίδικος υμών διάβολος ως λέων ωρυόμενος περιπατεί ζητών τίνα καταπιεί» (Α΄ Πέτρου, ε΄ 8). Δηλαδή εγκρατευθείτε, γίνετε άγρυπνοι και προσεκτικοί. Διότι ο αντίπαλος και κατήγορός σας ο διάβολος, σαν λιοντάρι που βρυχάται, περιπατεί με μανία και ζητάει ποιον να τραβήξει μακριά από την πίστη και να τον καταπιεί. Μετά την Ανάληψη του Κυρίου, ο Πέτρος, δίδαξε το Ευαγγέλιο στην Ιουδαία, στην Αντιόχεια, στον Πόντο, στην Γαλατία, στην Καππαδοκία, στην Ασία και τη Βιθυνία. Κατά την παράδοση (που σημαίνει ότι δεν είναι απόλυτα ιστορικά διασταυρωμένο) έφτασε μέχρι την Ρώμη, όπου επί Νέρωνος (54-68μ.Χ.) υπέστη μαρτυρικό θάνατο, αφού τον σταύρωσαν χιαστί, με το κεφάλι προς τα κάτω περί το έτος 64 μ.Χ.

Ο δε Παύλος γεννήθηκε στην Ταρσό της Κιλικίας σε ένα χωριό που ονομάζεται Γίσαλα και στην αρχή ήταν σκληρός διώκτης του Χριστιανισμού. Το 36 μ.Χ. περίπου, όταν κάποτε μετέβαινε στη Δαμασκό για να διώξει και εκεί χριστιανούς, έγινε θαύμα στο οποίο φανερώθηκε ο Χριστός, ο οποίος τον πρόσταξε να πάει στον Ανανία ο οποίος τον κατήχησε και τον βάπτισε. Έτσι, έγινε ο μεγαλύτερος κήρυκας του Ευαγγελίου, θυσιάζοντας μάλιστα και την ζωή του γι' αυτό. Ονομάστηκε ο πρώτος μετά τον Ένα και Απόστολος των Εθνών, λόγω των τεσσάρων μεγάλων αποστολικών περιοδειών του. Είναι ο ιδρυτής της Εκκλησίας της Ελλάδος. Συνέγραψε 14 επιστολές προς τις Εκκλησίες τις οποίες εκείνος ίδρυσε. Τη ζωή του με τις περιπέτειές του θα τα δει κανείς, αν μελετήσει τις Πράξεις των Αποστόλων, αλλά και τις 14 Επιστολές του στην Καινή Διαθήκη. Ο Απόστολος Παύλος θέλει κάθε χριστιανός, όπως και ο ίδιος, να αισθάνεται και να λέει: «ζω δε ουκέτι εγώ, ζη δε εν εμοί Χριστός» (Προς Γαλάτας β΄ 20). Δηλαδή, δε ζω πλέον εγώ, ο παλαιός άνθρωπος, αλλά ζει μέσα μου ο Χριστός. Και ακόμα, «τα πάντα και εν πάσι Χριστός» (Προς Κολασσαείς γ΄ 11). Να διευθύνει, δηλαδή, όλες τις εκδηλώσεις της ανθρώπινης ζωής μας ο Χριστός. Ο Απόστολος Παύλος υπέστη μαρτυρικό θάνατο (χωρίς να είναι απόλυτα ιστορικά διασταυρωμένο) δι' αποκεφαλισμού στη Ρώμη μεταξύ των ετών 64 - 67 μ.Χ.
